

Hampden Snore 2016- T&Cs

Terms and Conditions:

Participants

- Participants must be aged 16 or over on the day of the event, unless accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- The minimum participation age is 12 years old on the day of the event.
- Participants or their parent/guardian (for participants under 16 years old on the day of the event) must accept and agree that neither the organisers, nor their agents, officials, helpers, sponsors or fellow participants shall be liable in any way, or in any circumstances, for any damage, loss or injury that the participant may suffer during, in connection with, or as a result of partaking in this event, however caused.
- The event is held in a public place, the participant must agree they participate entirely at their own risk and are fully responsible for themselves and any children under 16 whom they are the parent/guardian for.
- Participants must be aware of the nature of the event and the associated medical and physical risks involved.

Safety

- Participants are fully responsible for their own safety and are expected to make careful decisions and exercise good judgement.
- Participants agree that they are solely responsible for their actions and decisions when participating in the Hampden Snore. They agree that they are responsible for their own safety, and to show due consideration for the safety of other participants, event staff/stewards and the general public whilst taking part in the event.
- Participants agree that there will be no consumption of alcohol or drugs during the event. Any use of these substances will result in immediate removal from the event.
- Participants agree that there will be no smoking within the event site. Any smoking within the event site will result in the participant's immediate removal from the event.

Event organisation

- Participants must always obey the instructions of the event organisers.
- Participants must obey the rules put in place by the event organiser. Additional rules may be added by the event organisers or stewards at any time.
- Event organisers have the right to remove a participant from the event at any time.
- While the Event Organisers takes every care with the staging of the Hampden Snore, the Participant acknowledges that no insurance is taken out by the Event Organiser on the Participant's behalf. Therefore, any and all insurance (including personal accident or personal items insurance) is the Participant's sole responsibility. The Participant is not eligible for compensation from the event organisers or other partner companies for the event, unless the event organiser or company has been negligent.

- The event organisers have the right to make changes to the location, registration process, start time or any other event features up to and including the day of the event. Where reasonably possible, participants will be notified of any changes.
- The event organiser is liable for any negligent activity which may or may not lead to harm or endanger the participants' welfare.
- Participants must inform a steward or the event organiser if they drop out of the event before completion.
- Participants must inform a steward or event organiser if they leave the event premises, even temporarily.

Fundraising

- All funds raised from the event, including gift aid, will be collected by Bethany Christian Trust. By registering and participating in this event you consent to all funds raised to be split equally between Bethany Christian Trust and Street Soccer.
- By registering for this event, you pledge to raise a minimum of £150 in sponsorship for Bethany Christian Trust and Street Soccer.
- Participants will pass on all sponsorship to Bethany Christian Trust by the 17th October.

Cancellation

- If safety issues for participants and staff arise the event organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event.
- If the event organisers cancel the event for reasons out with their control, this will be announced on the event website as soon as possible before the event, and participants will receive a registration fee refund minus an admin fee if requested by the participant.
- If the event is cancelled due to adverse or dangerous conditions any time after 17.00 on the Thursday before the event we will refund a percentage of the entry fee taking in account any outlaid costs.
- If a participant withdraws prior to or during the event, there will be no refund of the registration fee.
- In the event of a participant withdrawing prior to the Hampden Snore or due to cancellation of the event, donors have the option to request a refund of their sponsorship. This must be made in writing within 30 days of the event date.

Preparation

- Participants must ensure sure they are prepared for all adverse weather conditions.
- Participants agree that they are well enough to complete the event. The Event Organisers, its officers, employees, agents, affiliates, associated companies, sponsors or medical advisers are not responsible for any injury or illness that the Participant may suffer as a result of his/her participation in the Big Sleepout (unless caused due to the negligence of the Event Organiser).

Communications and publicity

- Communications will be sent to the contact details provided by the Participant upon his/her original application. It is the Participant's responsibility to ensure that their email address, telephone number and home address are correctly communicated to the event organiser.
- It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that the emergency contact details provided are correctly communicated to the organiser.
- The Participant consents to being photographed or filmed for use on websites, television shows, films, poster, advertising and other media platforms.
- The event organisers may contact you from time to time about future activities and events. Your contact details may be passed on to the official event photographers so that they can contact you regarding photos etc., however they will not pass your contact details onto any other Third Parties.

Data Protection

- Data Protection Act 1998: By submitting an application to take part in an event, the participants also allow the event organisers to use personal data for campaigns and activities connected to the events. The organisers shall have unlimited rights to publish pictures of the participants; to forward these photos to press representatives and to use them for marketing activities.
- All data received as part of this event will be shared amongst the event organisers, Bethany Christian Trust and Street Soccer.
